



## Course Descriptions:

**English (ESOL I)** This two-semester course is designed for beginner International students in grades 7 and 8. It covers listening, speaking, grammar, and vocabulary development. The course is designed to be taken in conjunction with English Lab. Students completing this course will be well-prepared for the high school ESOL English courses.

**English (ESOL II)** This two-semester course is designed for advanced beginner to low-intermediate International students in grades 9 and 10. It covers listening, speaking, reading, writing, grammar, and vocabulary development. The course is designed to be taken in conjunction with English Lab. Students completing this course usually proceed to ESOL III.

CREDITS: One high school English credit for the combined ESOL II + English Lab

**English (ESOL III)** This two-semester course is designed for intermediate students in grades 10-12. It covers listening, speaking, reading, and writing skills in the content area of English, focusing on academics. The course is designed to be taken in conjunction with English Lab. Students completing this course should be able to succeed (in varying degrees) in a mainstreamed English class.

CREDITS: One high school English credit for the combined ESOL II + English Lab

**English Bible** The Bible is the text and this class lays the foundation for understanding the Way, the Truth, and the Life. Today students are bombarded with negative influences and false messages. In this class we will search out examples of godly character traits and make personal application. Through scripture memory, journaling and daily devotionals, students will improve their English skills while growing in their personal understanding of and relationship with Jesus.

CREDITS: One high school Bible credit

**English Lab** This lab is an individualized, computer-enhanced approach to improving English language skills (CALL), either through remediation or acceleration. Lab must be taken along with ESOL I, II and III.
