

CCA PAC notes

November 18, 2010

The meeting began at 4:30 pm. Alice Pinard offered greetings and introduced Chantell Wheeler as the PAC coordinator for the year. Marilyn Sylvester opened in prayer. PAC classroom representatives were introduced and Alice provided the following information.

Chantell Wheeler offered a brief description of the PAC mission and will look at prior year notes and provide the mission statement.

CCA has received a promise of a donation of \$50K after January 1 earmarked for the construction of a fenced in playground. It is anticipated that the playground will cost \$75K-\$100K total. G. Rogers will oversee this process and a playground committee will be formed. CCA is looking at the possibility of a natural playground. It is anticipated that the playground will be located on the land adjacent to the elementary wing. Possible design options were made available at Grandparent's Day in October.

CCA has received an additional donation of \$50K which will be used to renovate the current 5th grade classroom and reception area into 2 classrooms totaling 1000 sq. feet. It is anticipated that this project will be completed over the Christmas break and that 5th grade will be relocated to the current 1st grade classroom.

Alice is pleased to report that the CCA deficit of \$100K as been paid in full and CCA plans to end the 2010-2011 school year in the black.

PAC members determined that it would be most efficient to divide the PAC meetings by EL and MS/HS. Considerable discussion resulted in the following meeting dates for the future EL PAC meetings.

Mrs. Pike provided an update regarding a new fundraising opportunity that is currently being used in other private schools. Proceeds from this fundraising opportunity will be divided evenly between the playground and the athletics program.
