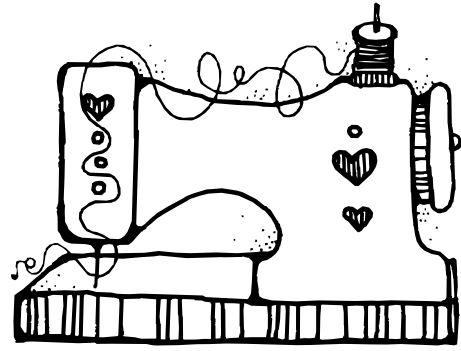


"SEW-FEST"PART 2
