

Elementary Art Teacher

They are intentional about showing Christ and His love through their teaching and care of the students. They will work to enable students to develop skills and competencies to reach their intellectual, creative and artistic potential.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Develop and deliver art lessons that align with the school's curriculum and educational standards.
- Teach students about various art techniques, styles, and mediums
- Encourage creativity and self-expression in students through art projects and assignments.
- Provide constructive feedback to students and communicate with parents about their child's progress.
- Create a safe and supportive classroom environment that fosters learning and creativity.
- Collaborate with other teachers and staff to integrate art into other subjects and school-wide events
- Stay up-to-date with new art techniques, technologies, and trends to enhance teaching methods and student learning.
- Participate in school-wide events and activities, such as art shows, exhibitions, and performances.
- Maintain accurate records of student attendance, grades, and progress.
- Other duties as assigned by the Dean of Academics
