The Van Driver is expected to demonstrate professionalism, uphold the school's values, and prioritize student safety and well-being at all times.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Safely operate a school van along assigned routes and schedules
- Ensure the safety and well-being of all student passengers at all times
- Maintain order and discipline on the van in alignment with school policies
- Conduct pre-trip and post-trip vehicle inspections and report any issues
- Follow all traffic laws, regulations, and school transportation policies
- Communicate effectively with school staff, parents, and students
- Maintain accurate records of mileage, student attendance, and incidents
- Assist students with boarding and exiting the vehicle as needed
- Represent the school in a professional and Christ-honoring manner
- Ensure cleanliness and general upkeep of the van
