LABELED ITEMS (with your child's name or initials on each item):

- NIV Bible (New International Version)
- One 1.5 inch 3-ring binder with a clear window on the front cover (to slide a paper in). Any color is fine. This will travel to school and back EVERY DAY so it should be a rugged one.
- One 2.5 or 3 inch (big) 3-ring binder (any color or style is fine) This will stay at school.
- 15 2-pocket folders WITH HOLES of each of the following colors to go in binders (plastic holds up best) TWO of each color except for the Homework folder: 2 purple for Bible, 2 blue for Math, 2 orange for Reading, 2 black for Spelling, 2 yellow for Language, 2 Green for Science/History, 2 Red for Newsletters, 1 (any color/picture) for Homework
- 2 spiral notebooks (any color or picture)
- pencil case (to go in desk)
- **Blue pens** (enough to be sure you have two each day) please individually initial with permanent marker
- #2 pencils, mechanical or regular (enough to be sure you have several each day) please individually initial with permanent marker
- Pencil top erasers and/or hand-held eraser (Pentel Hi-Polymer Erasers work well)
- Highlighters (at least 2 different colors) please individually initial with permanent marker
- Color pencils (no more than 12) please individually initial with permanent marker
- Markers (no more than 12) please individually initial with permanent marker
- Crayons (small box) please individually initial with permanent marker
- Watercolor paint set
- Scissors
- 2 glue sticks
- earbuds/headphones in a case or small bag both labeled with name
- Calculator
- Ruler with inch and centimeter
- Clipboard
- Protractor
- 1 package of black Expo markers and 1 small dry erase whiteboard and eraser
- hand sanitizer (personal size to keep at desk)
- 3 large book covers
